

## Maintenance Card for AC System

- PM Checklist:
  - Check operation of equipment before removing doors (using thermostat/remote)
  - Visual Inspection of system and all components (looking for water, corrosion, oils)
  - Wash or change filters if needed
  - Check Split of each indoor unit in operation
    - If split seems abnormal do the following
      - Check airflow (blower motor, plugged wheel/indoor coil)
      - Check condenser coil (dirty/ corroded fins)
      - Condenser fan motor
      - Line set (filter drier, metering device, restrictions)
      - Lastly, hook up gauges to check pressures.
  - o Inspect indoor unit for mold, mildew or dust
    - o If deep cleaning is needed report to customer/office
  - Check indoor unit drain pan for signs of backup or damage
  - o Insert condensate pan tablets
  - Clean traps if applicable
  - Check operation of float switches (breaks power to condenser)
  - Check condensate pump if applicable (float switch, age, sound, vinyl)
  - Check drain terminations (insects, mulch, pitch)
  - o Inspect outdoor condenser for debris, mulch, leaves, wear & tear. Recommend additional cleaning if applicable.
  - Ensure both outdoor and indoor units are properly pitched/level
  - Electrical
    - Inspect high voltage wiring and low voltage wiring
    - Check thermostat (batteries/ operation)
    - Check transformer for 24V (if lower than 22V recommend replacement)
    - Take Megohmmeter reading on compressor
    - Visual inspection of capacitor and contactor
      - Test components if corroded or noisy
